Classes for 2019 (PROVISIONAL – TO BE CONFIRMED WITH THE 2019 ACU HANDBOOK WHEN AVAILABLE)

Youth Age Groups

A Class: Born between 01.01.2002 and 31.12.2003- up to 125cc

B Class: Born between 01.01.2004 and 31.12.2006- up to 125cc

C Class: Born between 01.01.2007 and 31.12.2009- up to 80cc

D Class: Born between 01.01.2010 and 31.12.2013- up to 80cc Med Wheel

Note: To ride a combustion engined machine the rider must have attained 6yrs.

E Class: Minimum age must be 4 years and born after 01.01.2014
Electric powered machines up to 2 bhp

Hard Course: Experts, Intermediates, Novices and A Hard Class Youth do the hard course and this is for experienced riders.

Green Course: Adult & Youth. A combination of the hard and easy course and is for the experienced riders who do not wish to attempt the full hard course. Also known as 50/50

Main Course: Clubman, Twin Shock, Over 40 and all Youth Classes ie A, B, C. Deviation route on the main course for BE (Beginners over 9 years) and DH (D Hard).

Small Course: Separate conducted course for D Class. Deviation route on the small course for E Class .

Each course will have a Championship and other awards will be given. Riders must ride in at least three rounds to qualify. **Riders wishing to ride out of class or in a class that is not their elected RMC**

Championship class may do so on a non-competative basis.

Main Rules:

- All riders must hold a current 2019 ACU licence (day licences are available at £3 per day)
- All riders must wear a helmet, have legs covered and wear knee length boots.
- Youth riders must have arms covered, wear gloves and this is also recommended for adults.
- **Also all motorcycles used by Youth competitors must be fitted with an operational lanyard operated cut device rigidly connected to the rider by a lanyard (TSR8)**
- Richmond Motor Club forbid the wearing of cameras on any part of the body or machine whilst competing in a Richmond Motor Club Event. This decision comes following a number of accidents in which the wearing of a camera has caused injury. The decision was also made as it was considered that when helmet mounted there was also a risk of damaging the integrity of the helmet.
- Riders under 14 must have a parent or guardian present at the event at all times.
- Riders under 16 must have a responsible adult with them who remains at the event at all times.
- Offensive language will not be tolerated and may result in exclusion.
- Any rider or riders found to be doubling up without permission from the Clerk of the Course during any trial will be disqualified from the results.
- RIDERS MUST NOT PRACTICE BEFORE OR AFTER AN EVENT
- **All events are held on private land so we request that all dogs are on leads, leave no litter and do not return to any of the land at any time. The future of trials depends on this.**
