<u>Cut Out Device:</u> All competitors riding combustion engine machines must have cut out devices rigidly connected to the rider by a lanyard (max length1 metre) so as to stop the engine should the rider and machine be parted.

Start: The Start will be at Fremington Edge, Marske, North Yorkshire DL11 7LE

The first rider will start at 10.00 am the rest as per Championship regulations.

Method of Marking. The Championship will be held under TSR22 B

Awards Best Performance each class and 2nd and 3rd Place if sufficient entries .

<u>Course</u>: The course will be entirely on private land and will consist of a minimum of ten sections. There will be 3 routes as follows:

- Womens Championship Class will ride ROUTE 1
- Girls A Championship Class will ride 50% ROUTE 1 and 50% ROUTE 2
- Womens Intermediate Championship Class, Girls A Intermediate Championship Class Girls B Championship class will ride ROUTE 2
- Girls C Championship Class Womens ,Girls and Youth Sportsperson Non-Championship class will ride ROUTE 3
