CLASS C: JUNIORS: Standard Wheel as above.

Capacity Class for C Class: 80cc and Electric up to 7 BHP measured @ the rear wheel.

CLASS D: CADETS: Born Between 01.01.05 and 31.12.07. Medium Wheel (Maximum wheel size 19" front & 17" rear).

Capacity Class for D Class Medium Wheel: 80cc and Electric up to 7 BHP measured @ the rear wheel.

CLASS D: CADETS: Born Between 01.01.05 and 31.12.07. Small Wheel (Max wheel size 16" front & 14" rear).

Capacity Class for D Class Small Wheel: 50cc Mono and Electric up to 2 BHP measured @ the rear wheel, 80cc Twinshock .

Class D - Small Wheel, Combustion Engine machines (50cc Mono/80cc Twinshock)
