MARKING: Marking will be in accordance with TSR 22b (NO STOP). Ties in accordance with TSR23

MACHINES: Solo machines only. These shall be equipped in accordance with the ACU N.S.C. and TSR's. A noise test may be carried out.

PROTESTS: As per the National Sporting Code of the ACU section 10.04.

AWARDS: To qualify for an award a rider must complete all three days and awards will be based on total marks lost. **No Rider to win more than one award** (except Hard Course 1st Timer and Lady) Awards are:

Best Performance, 1st, 2nd & 3rd place Expert, Novice & Intermediate, Best Lady, Best First Timer & Best Local **Clubman Course Awards:**

Best Performance, 1st Clubman, 1st Over 40, 1st Over 50, 1st Twinshock, 6 first class awards, Best Local.

Daily awards will be given each day for the best ride on each course.
