DAILY START and ROUTE:

Each day will Start from the Event Headquarters

<u>Riders must sign on each day in the Secretaries Marquee</u> - Riders will be given punch cards to wear for Sunday's entire route. Please collect the your punch card when you sign on and return the first punch card at the lunch stop and the other to the Secretary at the end of your trial on Sunday.

LUNCHES for riders will be sponsored on Saturday & Sunday by Richmond Motor Club. Please take money with you for any extra drinks you may require.

<u>TIMES</u>: Please note your start times are on the list on the website. The time limit for each day is as follows Friday 6hrs, Saturday 7½hrs and Sunday 7hrs. Riders must start & finish at their allotted times. Riders will be penalised one mark per minute for exceeding their time limit. All riders must sign on at Event Headquarters each day, you will then be timed out from the Parks Field each day and timed off near the final section each day.

<u>PETROL</u>: will be transferred to a refuelling point on Friday, Saturday and Sunday so please bring identifiable and legal cans. You will require **TWO SEPARATE CANS EACH DAY**. The petrol wagon will leave the <u>EVENT</u> <u>HEADQUARTERS 10.30 am on Friday and 9.30am Saturday & Sunday</u>.

<u>ROUTE</u>: Bikes will be scrutineered after signing on at <u>Event Headquarters on Friday morning from 8am</u> This event is routed along and/or across public rights of way. Competitors must exercise caution and reduce their speed accordingly near other path users. The course passes several very sensitive historical and environmental areas for which permissions have taken a considerable amount of time securing. The future of this trial lies in the hands of you the riders. Please keep to the marked course at all times and make sure all followers and helpers respect other road users by parking sensibly. Landowners have stipulated that there must be **No dogs on the course**. **Strictly no smoking on any part of course**.

SOCIAL EVENTS/CAMPING etc

<u>CAMPING</u> and caravans are allowed on the event headquarters field in the designated area. Camping is for Competitors and families only. Please keep noise at night to a minimum so as not to upset local residents. All **generators** must be switched off between 11pm & 7am. The charge is <u>£15</u> per van/caravan/tent etc payable to Richmond Motor Club. You are requested to pay the secretary when signing on or a club official when they ask and a 'ticket' will be given for you to display on your tent/caravan. A Club official will be checking all van/caravan/tents so please make sure you display your 'ticket' prominently.

<u>TOILETS</u> will be available on the start field, and public toilets are available in Grinton (over the bridge, past the Bridge Inn on the left hand side) **THERE IS A CHEMICAL DISPOSAL POINT ON SITE, PLEASE USE TO DISPOSE OF YOUR CHEMICAL TOILET USE AND <u>DO NOT</u> USE THE TOILET BLOCK FOR THIS PURPOSE.** Please help us to keep the main toilet block in good working order. Any reports of misuse will be acted on.

Please put all rubbish in the containers provided. Please remember no open fires on the campsite and please do not light Chinese lanterns as we have had tents damaged in previous years. There will be catering available from breakfast throughout the weekend.

The Burger Queen will be on site all weekend providing refreshments and a bar.

FRIDAY NIGHT: CARVERY SUPPER - 6.30 PM ONWARDS IN THE MARQUEE

Riders you will receive your complimentary ticket with your pack when you sign in on Friday morning along with any additional tickets that you have purchased. Please bring your tickets with you. No ticket no carvery! There will be live music provided by Dizzy Blonde with band member Gary Thwaite from 8.30 pm. Please come along and support them.

SATURDAY NIGHT: BUFFET SUPPER - 6.30 PM ONWARDS IN THE MARQUEE
