Dear Rider

Thank you for your entry. Your riding number and start time are shown on the Rider Entry List.

**TIME ALLOWED: 6 HOURS**

**START:** Town Foot Farm, Carlton, North Yorkshire, DL8 4BA. The start will be SILENT.  
**Time of start 10am. Please collect your number from the secretary from 9am, wearing your Mask.**

**COURSE:** One lap approx. 30 miles and 40 sections in Coverdale and Wensleydale.  
Roadwork will be involved; bikes and riders must be road legal.

**PETROL:** **TWO CANS** WILL BE REQUIRED. PETROL WILL BE TRANSPORTED TO APPROPRIATE  
REFUELLING POINTS. **THESE MUST BE AT THE START BY 9.15AM**

**TIME:** **One Rider starts at 20 Second intervals. First rider starts at 10.00am.** Riders will be penalised  
for late starting and late finishing one mark per minute up to 20 and thereafter excluded.  
As per TSR 16.  
**Riders will be timed off at the last group of Sections. This will remove the need for speeding back**  
Please leave and enter the start field with care.

**MARKING:** Marks will be lost on 1,2,3,5 basis. This will be a Non Stop Trial TSR22b. Ties will be resolved by  
most cleans, most ones, twos, threes etc as per TSR 23.

**MACHINES:** Machines must be suitable and comply with Road Traffic Act.

**PROTESTS:** As per the National Sporting Code of the ACU, Section 10.04

PLEASE INFORM CHRIS WALLIS OF ANY CANCELLATIONS AS SOON AS POSSIBLE. If you do not inform the secretary of

and ACU charge.

THERE MUST BE NO OTHER BIKES ON THE COURSE OTHER THAN ENTERED RIDERS  
THIS EVENT IS ROUTED ALONG/AND/OR ACROSS PUBLIC RIGHTS OF WAY. COMPETITORS MUST EXERCISE CAUTION  
AND REDUCE THEIR SPEED ACCORDINGLY NEAR OTHER PATH USERS. BE ESPECIALLY CAREFUL NEAR HORSES. SLOW  
DOWN, STOP AND SWITCH OFF YOUR ENGINE IF NECESSARY, RIDERS MUST OBSERVE ALL SPEED LIMITS AND RIDE WITH  
CARE AND ATTENTION THROUGH ALL VILLAGES. **ANY RIDERS REPORTED TO THE CLERK OF THE COURSE FOR NON  
OBSERVANCE OF THESE RULES WILL BE EXCLUDED.**

MUCH OF THE COURSE IS ON VERY ENVIRONMENTALLY SENSITIVE GROUND AND THEREFORE RIDERS MUST KEEP TO  
FLAGGED COURSE AT ALL TIMES. **PENALTY WILL BE EXCLUSION.**

**THERE WILL BE NO REFRESHMENTS AVAILABLE AT THE START OR LUNCH STOP THIS YEAR – PLEASE BRING YOUR OWN.**

**PLEASE BE AWARE OF YOUNG BIRD CHICKS STRAYING ON TO THE COURSE and**  
**KEEP TO THE MARKED ROUTE AND OFF THE GROUSE MOORS!!! THE FUTURE OF THIS TRIAL IS IN YOUR HANDS**  
**PLEASE DO NOT SMOKE TO REDUCE ANY RISK OF FIRE ON THE COURSE**

## **COVID - Club Supplementary Safety Procedure for Event**

### **Please read all the following instruction before proceeding into the venue**

Competitors / Officials or someone in their household or support bubble showing coronavirus symptoms, everyone in that household / support bubble should stay at home. If a competitor / official or a member of the household or support bubble are contacted as part of the test and trace programme, the individual contacted should stay at home. If that individual becomes symptomatic, everyone in the support bubble must self-isolate and stay at home.

- Do NOT enter if you have the following symptoms-
  - A high temperature
  - A new continuous cough
  - Change in sense of taste or smell

**If you have any of the above, turn around and go home**

- No entries will be accepted on the day (pre-entries only).
- Always observe social distancing and follow event signage.
- Sanitise hands when instructed to do so.
- No spectators allowed.

Instructions –

1. Park your vehicle ideally 2m away from the next vehicle.
2. Facemasks must be worn in the start and communal areas.
3. Proceed to the event secretaries station observing entry and exit signage maintaining social distancing from other competitors and officials.
4. Collect your riding number from the secretaries car.
5. Return to your vehicle until the start of the event.

**Proceed to the start at your allotted time.**

During the event –

- No more than 3 people at any one time to walk a section (in one direction only), exit the section at the end and return to your machine, do NOT walk back down the section.
- Maximum of 6 people to queue at a section at a spacing of 2m. If there are already 6 people in the queue either stop and wait or proceed to the next section.
- Do NOT approach the observer.
- If a marker flag is dislodged the rider is responsible for replacing it at the direction of the observer.
- On completion of the event please return to your vehicle immediately.
- No practicing before or after the event.

These rules must be followed, and we will be operating a zero-tolerance policy for any breaches.
