ANNOUNCEMENT: -The Richmond Motor Club (Yorks) Ltd. will organise a 3 Day Championship SOLO Semi Sporting Trial on July 22,23,24 July 2022 held under the National Sporting Code, Standing Regulations of the ACU, the following Supplementary Regulations and any final instructions issued for the meeting. There will be a modified route for O40, O50, C/Man & Twinshock riders and a Green Course, using a mixture of Hard Course and Clubman Course sections. **Some access to the sections will be on the public highway.**

ELIGIBILITY: - All riders and passengers must hold a current ACU Trials Registration /Membership or a SACU licence or ACU/SACU rider's licence. Any rider or passenger from another FMN MUST produce a licence issued by their FMN together with start permission and proof of personal accident Insurance.

COVID-19: Individuals need to take responsibility for their own safety and exercise judgement as appropriate. The event will be run under the current recommendations issued by the Government and the ACU and must be adhered to. In the event of domestic and international restrictions being applied RMC reserves the right to refuse entry.

The organisers reserve the right to refuse an entry in accordance with NSC 4.10. Entry fees will only be returned if the championship is cancelled. The entry fee also includes two £5 food vouchers to use at the onsite catering facilities at Parks Field, a Reeth Three Day Shirt, lunch on Saturday and Sunday. **Entry limit 200**

MARKING: Marking will be in accordance with TSR 22b (NO STOP). Ties in accordance with TSR23

MACHINES: Solo machines only. These shall be equipped in accordance with the ACU N.S.C. and TSR's. A noise test may be carried out.

PROTESTS: As per the National Sporting Code of the ACU section 10.04.

AWARDS: To qualify for an award a rider must complete all three days and awards will be based on total marks lost.

Hard Course Awards: Cliff Addison Memorial Trophy for Best Performance on the Hard Course 1st, 2nd & 3rd place Expert, Intermediate & Novice,

Best First Timer & Best Local

Clubman A Course Awards:

Best Performance, 2nd and 3rd place. Best Local

Clubman B Course Awards: Shield for the Best Performance on the Clubman B Course 1st Clubman A, 1st Over 40, 1st Over 50, 1st Twinshock, 3 first class awards. Best Local

Best Lady (if not awarded on the Hard Course will be awarded to Best Lady on Clubman A Course or then the Clubman B Course)
