Final Instructions

<u>Signing On</u>: Opens at 9:00am. Riders, along with their Parents/Guardians and Assistants must sign on to collect their punch cards, bibs and bike numbers, prior to scrutineering.

<u>Scrutineering</u>: 9:00 - 9:30 an All competitors must arrive with boots, helmet and gloves, have cut out devices rigidly connected to the rider by a lanyard (max length 1 metre) to stop the engine should the rider and machine be parted. These will all be checked during scrutineering.

Observers Briefing: 9:30am Prompt, in the Scrutineering Area.

Riders Briefing: 9:45am Prompt, in the Scrutineering Area.

<u>Start:</u> First rider at 10:00am. Thereafter riders will start at 1-minute intervals.

Course: 3 Laps Of 12 Sections, approximate length of the course is 1 mile. A Class standard wheel (route 1)- will follow the principal route Blue(left) and Red(right) B Class standard wheel (route 2)- will follow the principal route then the Yellow deviation C Class standard wheel (route 3)- will follow the principal route then the Green deviation C Class -medium wheel will follow 50% of route 3 and 50% of route 4 as directed at the section start D Class -medium wheel (route 4)- will follow the principal route then the **Black** deviation

D Class -Small Wheel (route 5)- will follow the principal route then the White deviation

Method of Marking: TSR22(b) NON-STOP

Punch Cards: To be changed after each lap at the signing-on gazebo. Looking after the punch card rests entirely with the rider and only the rider may present the punch card to the observer, unless the rider is in the C & D class age group and the assistant of that rider may look after it and present the punch card to the observer.

<u>Assistants</u>: Riders may register one assistant to accompany them on the course for a fee of £2.00, providing he/she is not riding a machine. The assistant must be a minimum age of 18 and must sign on at the start. The assistant must wear identification provided by the organiser. The assistant will only be allowed into the section if their rider is in the section and with the permission of the official – ASK BEFORE ENTERING!

Overall Time Allowance: 6:00 hrs. The rider is obliged to go directly from the Final Time Control located at the last section to the Results Recorder. Any rider who delays the publication of a result will be reported to the Stewards of the Meeting for disciplinary action.

<u>Protests</u>: Protests must be made within 30 minutes of the publication of the results on the Scoreboard displayed at the event.

<u>General</u>: Overnight camping (£5 a night) is available in the field with toilets from Friday night until Sunday, please bring your own water. Catering will be available during the event. Awards will be presented, and results published as soon as possible after the event. Please take your rubbish home.

Polite Notice: Please do not enter the course prior to the event, including Friday evening. Riders found to be on the course prior to the event will be excluded.

Dogs must always be kept on leads.
