DAILY START and ROUTE:

Each day will Start from the Event Headquarters

<u>Riders must sign on each day in the Secretaries Marquee:</u> - Riders will be given punch cards to wear for Sunday's entire route. Please collect your first punch card when you sign on, on Sunday morning and return this punch card at the lunch stop where you pick up your second card. Please return this to the Secretary at the end of the trial Sunday as soon as you get back.

<u>TIMES</u>: Please note your start times are on the list on the website. The time limit for each day is as follows Friday 6hrs, Saturday 7½ hrs and Sunday 7hrs. Riders must start & finish at their allotted times. Riders will be penalised one mark per minute for exceeding their time limit. All riders must sign on at Event Headquarters each day, you will then be timed out from the Woodyard each day and timed off near the final section each day.

<u>PETROL</u>: will be transferred to a refuelling point on Friday, Saturday and Sunday so please bring identifiable and legal cans. You will require **ONE CAN ON FRIDAY, TWO** <u>FULL</u> SEPARATE CANS ON SATURDAY & TWO SEPARATE CANS SUNDAY. The petrol wagon will leave the <u>EVENT HEADQUARTERS at 10.30 am on Friday</u> and **9.30am** Saturday & Sunday.

<u>ROUTE</u>: Bikes will be scrutineered after signing on at <u>Event Headquarters on Friday morning from 8am</u> This event is routed along and/or across public rights of way. Competitors must exercise caution and reduce their speed accordingly near other path users. The course passes several very sensitive historical and environmental areas for which permissions have taken a considerable amount of time securing. The future of this trial lies in the hands of you the riders. Please keep to the marked course at all times and make sure all followers and helpers respect other road users by parking sensibly. Landowners have stipulated that **dogs must be kept on leads at all times and under close control**. **Strictly no smoking on any part of course**.

SOCIAL EVENTS/CAMPING etc

CAMPING AND CARAVANS: are allowed on the event headquarters field in the designated area. Camping is for Competitors and families only. Please keep noise at night to a minimum so as not to upset local residents. All generators must be switched off between 11pm & 7am. The charge is £30 per van/caravan/tent etc payable to Richmond Motor Club. You are requested to pay the club official when they ask and a 'ticket' will be given for you to display on your tent/caravan. A Club official will be checking all van/caravan/tents so please make sure you display your 'ticket' prominently. Any abuse or refusal to pay will NOT be tolerated.

<u>TOILETS</u> will be available on the start field, and public toilets are available in Grinton (over the bridge, past the Bridge Inn on the left-hand side) or in Reeth (near the Buck Hotel) **THERE IS A CHEMICAL DISPOSAL POINT ON SITE, PLEASE USE TO DISPOSE OF YOUR CHEMICAL TOILET USE AND <u>DO NOT</u> USE THE TOILET BLOCK FOR THIS PURPOSE**. Please help us to keep the main toilet block in good working order. Any reports of misuse will be acted on.

SHOWERS will be available in the start field. Please leave these as you find them (nice and clean!) and limit the length of the shower. Please look after this facility as they are expensive to hire.

<u>WASTE</u> put all rubbish in the containers provided. Please remember no open fires on the campsite and please do not light Chinese lanterns as we have had tents damaged in previous years.

Caterers will be on site all weekend providing refreshments & there will be a Fish and Chip

van Saturday from 4pm - 8pm

Richmond Motor Club will be running a bar in the marquee!!

<u>FRIDAY NIGHT</u>: The Last Section Bar will be open from 3 – 12 pm (may change dependent on demand) please come and support us and get a great atmosphere going. No Happy Hour as EVERY hour will be happy hour at these prices!.
