<u>TIMES</u>: Please note your start times are on the list on the website. The time limit for each day is as follows **Friday** 6 hrs, **Saturday 7** hrs and **Sunday 6.5** hrs. Riders must start & finish at their allotted times. Riders will be penalised one mark per minute for exceeding their time limit. All riders must sign on at Event Headquarters each day, you will then be timed out from the Woodyard each day and timed off at the final section each day.

<u>PETROL</u>: will be transferred to a refuelling point on Friday, Saturday and Sunday so please bring identifiable and legal cans. You will require **TWO SEPARATE FUEL CANS FOR FRIDAY AND SATURDAY AND TWO FULL CANS FOR 3 STOPS ON SUNDAY**. The petrol wagon will leave the **EVENT HEADQUARTERS at 10.30 am** on Friday and **9.30am** Saturday & Sunday. (At each stop fill up)

<u>SCRUTINEERING:</u> Bikes will be scrutineered after signing on from 8am on Friday morning until 10am sharp. Please ensure you mount your number board prior to scrutineering.

COURSE: -Expert, Intermediate & Novice follow the principal route, red and blue flags.

- -Clubman A follow the principal route then the yellow deviation unless otherwise directed at the start of the section (50/50).
- -Clubman B follow the principal route then the yellow deviation.

ROUTE: This event is routed along and/or across public rights of way. Competitors must exercise caution and reduce their speed accordingly near other path users. The course passes several very sensitive historical and environmental areas for which permissions have taken a considerable amount of time securing. The future of this trial lies in the hands of you the riders. Please always keep to the marked course and make sure all followers and helpers respect other road users by parking sensibly. Landowners have stipulated that **dogs must be always kept on leads and under close control**. **Strictly no smoking on any part of course**.

SOCIAL EVENTS/CAMPING

<u>CAMPING AND CARAVANS</u> are allowed on the event headquarters field in the designated area. Camping is for Competitors and families only. Please keep noise at night to a minimum so as not to upset residents. All **generators** must be switched off between 11pm & 7am. The charge is <u>£40</u> per van/caravan/tent etc payable to Richmond Motor Club. You are requested to pay the club official when they ask, a 'ticket' will be given for you to display on your tent/caravan. A Club official will be checking all van/caravan/tents so please make sure you display your 'ticket' prominently. Any abuse or refusal to pay will NOT be tolerated.

<u>TOILETS</u> will be available on the start field, and public toilets are available in Grinton (over the bridge, past the Bridge Inn on the left-hand side) or in Reeth (near the Buck Hotel for 20p) **THERE IS A CHEMICAL DISPOSAL POINT ON SITE, PLEASE USE TO DISPOSE OF YOUR CHEMICAL TOILET USE AND <u>DO NOT</u> USE THE TOILET BLOCK FOR THIS PURPOSE**. Please help us to keep the main toilet block in good working order. Any reports of misuse will be acted on.

SHOWERS will be available in the start field. Please leave these as you find them (nice and clean!) and limit the length of the shower. Please look after this facility as they are expensive to hire.

<u>WASTE</u> put all rubbish in the containers provided. Please remember no open fires on the campsite and please do not light Chinese lanterns as we have had tents damaged in previous years.

DO NOT PUT ANY TYRES IN THE SKIPS
